This FREE service is for end-users to recycle genuine OEM printer consumables and all the costs are covered by the OEMs.

Print-Recycle is our chargeable service, that can be used for the recycling of all consumables, compatibles as well as OEM.

This can be used separately or alongside the Circular Planet service.

For an additional cost and small monthly fee, you can have your own-branded portal - giving your customers a value-added service and more recognition of the recycling service as being yours.

The Details

You can use a combination of more than 1 service for your customers.

If there are only genuine OEM consumables, then Circular Planet's free service is the best solution. If there are non-OEM consumables then it will need to be Print-Recycle, or your own branded portal.

If your customer is happy to split the products, Circular Planet could be used to recycle the OEM products for Free and everything else can be recycled through Print-Recycle.

We can collect any box as long as it is sealed securely and within the courier restrictions as detailed on the portal when booking a collection. Our boxes are specifically designed for this service and are supplied with bag and tape, so we recommend using our boxes where possible.

All printer consumables can be recycled: toners / inks / drums / fusers / transfer & maintenance kits and full waste toner containers

Genuine Recycling

Zero Landfill

Some companies claim to recycle, but you should check what they mean and what their process is. Simply shredding products into plastics and metals is not recycling. Don't just take their word – do your full due diligence to check. We have an open-door policy and you can see the cleaned, separated raw materials that we produce at our facility in Oldham, UK.

What comes out of the waste process and where the products / materials go next is key to understanding whether genuine recycling has taken place.

Products that can be reused are sent back to the manufacturer.

If they can't be reused then we put the products through our unique raw-material recovery process to generate cleaned and separate plastics and metals – these are then supplied to organisations that can use them to make new products.

Any non-reusable materials are sent for incineration – we pay more to use a local site that produces energy from the thermal recovery process.

We are committed to zero landfill.

WTN / COR Documents

Waste Transfer Note (WTN)

A simple document to record where waste was produced, who moved it, when it was moved and where it was moved to.

Any organisation can pay £105 to obtain a waste carrier license for 3 years. Then the company can move and receive waste using the WTN as documentation.

This is evidence for the movement of waste – it is **not proof of recycling**.

Certificate of Recycling (COR)

A signed document from our company to declare that we have followed the proper and genuine recycling processes with your waste.

This is evidence for the recycling of waste – it is also not proof of recycling, after all, it is just a document. But it is our signed declaration and we are accountable to it.

We issue a WTN for every collection we make.

We issue a COR for all the waste we process – we are not legally required to do so, but we do. This should give you some reassurance and **we encourage you to audit our processes with full due diligence.**

Due Diligence Checklist

- Compliant with HSE recommendation to 'remove contaminants prior to shredding / dismantling / recycling'
- Using Best Available Treatment Recovery & Recycling Techniques
- Zero landfill & only minimum thermal incineration
- Cleaned & separated raw-material outputs
- Valid Environmental Licenses, Registrations and Exemptions (see below)
